The Second Service Foundation Partners with Business Beyond the Battlefield Conference to Support Veteran Entrepreneurs

[August 4, 2023] - The Second Service Foundation has joined with Business Beyond the Battlefield Conference to provide education and resources for veteran entrepreneurs. The annual Business Beyond the Battlefield Conference (BBBC) is a three-day event in Arlington, TX, on October 4-6, filled with coaching, mentorship, and networking opportunities. During BBBC, the Second Service Foundation will host its Military Entrepreneur Challenge, a pitch competition that awards thousands of dollars in early-stage and social-impact capital to military-connected small businesses. Along with the monetary prizes and a \$5,000 PR package, Holland & Knight LLP will award pro bono legal services valued at \$25,000.

The Second Service Foundation was founded in 2016 by Mark L. Rockefeller to help veteran and military-spouse entrepreneurs. As BBBC and the Second Service Foundation are both part of the D'Aniello Institute for Veterans & Military Families (IVMF) Community Navigator Pilot Program, they recognized the power in joining forces to help military-connected small business owners with coaching, capital, and resources.
